All Class 1 PEI will be required as a minimum to have successfully challenged this exam within the last five years of this application.

This provincial examination covers the *Boiler and Pressure Vessel Act, Regulations* and CSA B51-09. It is intended to educate and demonstrate the applicant's knowledge of Saskatchewan and Canadian requirements.

It is intended to educate and demonstrate the applicant's knowledge of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspection, Pressure Equipment Inspectors duties and requirements, and requirements for inspection under a Quality Management System. It is mandatory for those Pressure Equipment Inspectors whose five year Licence is expired and due for renewal.
