- A minimum 5 years of experience in performing field evaluations on electrical equipment in accordance with the SPE-1000 standard for an approved inspection body;
- Thorough knowledge of Canadian Electrical Code, Part 2 standards and other electrical standards required for field evaluation of electrical equipment;
- A minimum 5 years experience as a Journeyman Electrician;
- Electrical Inspection experience with an Authority Having Jurisdiction.

Our ideal candidate will have a proven record of participating in standards development through:

- Conducting standards research;
- Membership of a standards development committee;
- Providing feedback on a standard in draft form during public review;
- Contributing to standards development.

This position will play an integral role in the transfer of knowledge for Electrical Inspectors and will be expected to:

- Engage others in order to reach goals and objectives
- Proactively anticipate potential problems, identify core issues and draw accurate conclusions to resolve
