PROOF OF VACCINATION POLICY

Attention all power engineers, boiler operators, pressure equipment inspectors, welders and any other person(s) attending a testing/ seminar offered by TSASK

“Effective October 01, 2021, a provincial requirement for proof of vaccination or negative test will be implemented for public access to [...] businesses that bring groups of people together”.

In alignment with the Government of Saskatchewan and adhering to our vision as “being recognized as a leading safety authority - a Saskatchewan service provider, inspiring and shaping excellence in public safety” TSASK will be implementing a proof of full vaccination or negative test policy for all our examination sittings/testing sites and seminars within the province.

When you arrive at the examination sitting/testing site or seminar location, **you will be required to provide the administrator with proof of full vaccination OR proof of a negative COVID-19 test result.** If you cannot provide either of the above, you will be unable to participate in the scheduled TSASK event. For confidentiality reasons, your documentation will not be retained and will be required at all subsequent events for the foreseeable future.

The only acceptable form of vaccination is:

- SHA COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate with QR Code (printed or digital) and photo ID.

Proof of a negative test:

- Individuals who do not have proof of full vaccination have the option of providing proof of a negative COVID-19 test result from within the **previous 72 hours.**
- A self-administered take-home rapid antigen test will not be accepted as valid proof of negative COVID-19 test results. Individuals requiring a negative test result have several private options on the market that will provide a rapid antigen test or a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test for a fee.

All applications are non-refundable and non-transferrable. If you are unable to obtain documentation prior to your scheduled event, TSASK will not reschedule. You will need to reapply and repay for another date.



TSASK staff will not tolerate any verbal abuse in regard to this policy. If there is any conflict on being required to provide the above-mentioned documentation, TSASK management will review the incident for further disciplinary action that may be taken.

Please note that details are still being finalized by the province and TSASK, but we have sent this in the interest of getting you as much information as possible in a timely manner.

Thank you for your understanding and cooperation during these uncertain times.

******Proof of full vaccination means that you are fully vaccinated, including the 2-week waiting period after your 2nd dose. If you have only had 1 dose, or the 2 weeks has not passed from the date of your 2nd dose, a negative COVID test result is still required******

******All documentation must be official and contain your first and last name as it will be verified against your SGI issued photo ID******
